building was J. Peavey & Bro's, built in 1874. The southernmost building was built for Pomerleau.

The original building has always been a bank but has undergone several name changes over the decades, including Fleet Bank, Bank of America & Camden National Bank. Elm City Tobacco and Atherton's Furniture have previously occupied the southern building.

The Federal Trust Company was founded in 1923. The original Federal Trust Building was built in 1926 in traditional style adorned with "Moderne" architectural motifs that were popular for Federal government buildings.

Much of the original ornamentation, including the ornate door and decorative spandrels beneath the 2nd and 3rd floor windows, was replaced when the building was expanded by two thirds to the south. The middle
