

TICONIC ROW

8-22 Main Street ~ Map #30



Originally built in 1836 in Greek Revival style architecture, this set of buildings underwent major renovations in 1924 when the gable roof and dormers were replaced to add a fourth story. Each building bears a granite tablet of the person responsible for the renovations. They were Sarah Levine, where the original Levine's Clothing Store began, Tozier-Dow, Abraham



Joseph and Gabrielle Pomerleau. These names reflect the change in ethnic composition of Waterville by the early 1900s.



These buildings were recently purchased by Colby College and plans are underway to revitalize and restore the buildings.
